
What is an energy community?

How to finance a Renewable Energy Community

- Local administrations can fund a PV plant on a public building by using a state grant. In this case, the administration draw up a document where it officially provide the community with the energy of that PV plant;
- In Italy, the **national recovery and resilience plan** will grant municipalities with less than 5.000 inhabitants who wants to activate a REC (interest-free grants).
- Rental of the PV plant installed by a third investor.
- Capital raising among the members of the REC (for small PV plant).
- Bank financing

REC Ussaramanna (Sud Sardinia)



- 14th July2021: Constituent Assembly of the juridical subject;
- PV plant of about 60kWp;
- 62 founding members;
- For the municipality, the REC is becoming a subject to consult for local energy policy;
- The aim is also to develop a **guidance service** in order to encourage **private energy efficiency investments**, promote **cooperative of community** with the activation of other services.
